7th Grade Design Technology

Use the tools in Inkscape to create a combination mark logo of one of the great attributes of leaders or designers on the wall of the Design Lab.

A combination mark logo includes text and a symbol or icon.

Requirements

- 1. The attribute you choose should be appropriate and approved by Mr. Mickelson
 - a. If the attribute you choose is a noun, change it to a verb or adjective in your logo
 - i. Creativity → Create
 - ii. Confidence → Be confident
- 2. The symbol can be drawn or imported from the web
 - a. If imported, there needs to be zero background on the symbol
- 3. Black logo on transparent background only

Tools and Tips

In addition to the Select and shape tools in the Tool palette, you should also be using:

- 1. Text Object tool (in Tool palette)
- 2. Import command (CONTROL + I).
- 3. Image web search
 - a. To find impactful symbols to use in your logo, include the word "silhouette" in your search (example: "hand shake silhouette")
 - b. Simple visuals with white or no backgrounds work best

 - a. Example. davidlogo.svg
- 4. Save as .SVG format
- 5. Save in your folder inside Documents
